TOPIC	DISCUSSION
Approval of Minute	Committee Member Rudzena moved to approve August 26, 2025 public works committee minutes as written. Committee Member Steffens seconded the motion. All Committee Members present voted aye, motion carried.
Old Business	Public Works Foreman D. Walsh briefed the committee on culvert driveway requests, tree trimming and ditch mowing operations, blacktop patching, vehicle maintenance fleet update and preparation for winter operations. Currently immediate look-ahead on water main exercising on valves and sewer plant winterization. No major reporting issues and look ahead from Public Work Foreman Walsh outside of well house water tank needs attention from pin-hole repair needed, but plans and operations in place during evening/night hours to avoid burden on residents and infrastructure. Member Gallina expressed concerns on behalf of surrounding residents regarding the materials and final surface treatment proposed for the Johnsburg Road resurfacing, as compared to those used in the 2025 subdivision road resurfacing program. Discussion among the committee continued regarding scopes, materials used, practices need and oversight from consultants on awarded bidders performing the projects.
New Business	Snow & Ice Policy within Public Works and on the Villages website was shared and reviewed by Public Works committee.
Chairman Report	Chairman Letzter updated committee the with recent Village Board action activities and discussed next meeting tentatively proposed schedule. Discussion among committee regarding specifically on Solar Farm outside Village boundaries, but Chairman shared the Boards actions to object. Staff to keep committee informed on scheduling if needed.
Adjournment	Committee Member Rudzena moved to adjourn. Committee Member Pingitore seconded the motion. All Committee Members present voted aye. Motion carried at 7:26p.
