## ORDINANCE NO. 2024-25-09

## An Ordinance Accepting the Roadway Commonly Known as Sunnyside Beach Drive in the Village of Johnsburg, Illinois

WHEREAS, Sunnyside Beach Drive was a privately maintained road; and

WHEREAS, residents residing and/or owning property on Sunnyside Beach Drive (the "Residents") desired to upgrade Sunnyside Beach Drive (the "Road") in accordance with public road standards so that the Village of Johnsburg (the "Village") could accept the Road and take over future maintenance of same; and

WHEREAS, the Residents petitioned the Village to establish a Special Service Area for the cost of the Road improvements; and

WHEREAS, the Village approved Ordinance 20-21-41 Establishing Village of Johnsburg Special Service Area 33 on April 20, 2021 in response to the Resident's petition;

WHEREAS, the Village approved Ordinance 20-21-42 Providing for the Issuance of Special Service Area Bonds to fund the project; and

WHEREAS, on May 2, 2023, the Village awarded the road construction project to Lenny Hoffmann Excavating (the "Contractor"); and

WHEREAS, on September 17, 2024, the Village acknowledged the completion of the improvements in accordance with public road standards and authorized final payment to the Contractor; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Johnsburg, McHenry County, Illinois, as follows:

SECTION 1: The Village hereby accepts the Road as depicted in Exhibit A commonly known as Sunnyside Beach Drive and legally described as follows;

That part of the Northwest and Northeast Quarters of Section 18, Township 45 North, Range 9 East of the Third Principal Meridian described as follows: Beginning at the most Northerly corner of Lot 1 in Sunnyside Beach Subdivision, according to the plat thereof recorded October 2, 1916 as Document No. 36512; thence South 59 degrees 05 minutes 00 seconds West along the Southerly line of Sunnyside Beach Drive per Document No. 36512, a distance of 476.77 feet to the Easterly extension of the Southerly line of a Driveway as shown on the First Addition to Elam's Four Mile Water, according to the plat thereof

recorded June 31, 1924 as Document No. 64619; thence South 88 degrees 42 minutes 15 seconds West along said Southerly line, 321.77 feet to the Northeast corner of Sunnyside Beach Drive per Document No. 64619; thence South 19 degrees 18 minutes 44 seconds West along the Easterly line of said Sunnyside Beach Drive, 119.84 feet; thence South 58 degrees 38 minutes 47 seconds West along the Southerly line of said Sunnyside Beach drive and the Westerly extension thereof, 299.39 feet to the Northwesterly extension of the Northeasterly line of Lot 11 in Elam's Four Mile Water, according to the plat thereof recorded August 27, 1920 as Document No. 48644; thence South 30 degrees 37 minutes 40 seconds East along said Northwesterly extension of the Northeasterly line of said Lot 11, a distance of 81.99 feet to a line 50.00 feet Northerly of and parallel with the Northerly line of Lots 11 through 18 in said Elam's Four Mile Water; thence South 58 degrees 21 minutes 39 seconds West along said parallel line, 99.50 feet; thence South 53 degrees 36 minutes 39 seconds West along said parallel line and the Southwesterly extension thereof, 407.05 feet to the Southerly line of Sunnyside Beach Drive per Document No. 2021R0015196; thence the following six (6) courses along said Southerly line of Sunnyside Beach Drive; 1) thence North 36 degrees 23 minutes 21 seconds West, 20.00 feet; 2) thence North 53 degrees 36 minutes 39 seconds East, 407.88 feet; 3) thence North 58 degrees 21 minutes 39 seconds East, 80.68 feet; 4) thence North 30 degrees 37 minutes 40 seconds West, 82.09 feet; 5) thence North 58 degrees 38 minutes 47 seconds East, 311.99 feet; 6) thence North 19 degrees 18 minutes 44 seconds East, 105.17 feet; thence North 01 degrees 17 minutes 45 seconds West, 60.00 to the Northerly line of Sunnyside Beach Drive per Document No. 362262; thence North 88 degrees 42 minutes 15 seconds East along said Northerly line, 246.07 feet; thence 158.77 feet Northeasterly along said Northerly line, being a curve to the left, having a radius of 307.11 feet, a chord bearing of North 73 degrees 53 minutes 37 seconds East and a chord length of 157.01; thence continuing along said Northerly line North 59 degrees 05 minutes 00 seconds East, 416.50 feet to the Southeast corner of Lot 13 in Thelen's Lakeview Subdivision, according to the plat thereof recorded April 24, 1957 as Document No. 362262; thence South 00 degrees 36 minutes 14 seconds West along the West line of the Northeast Quarter of said Section 18, 29.33 feet to the Northerly line of Sunnyside Beach Drive per Document Nos. 143096 and 136856; thence North 59 degrees 05 minutes 00 seconds East along said Northerly line, 319.88 feet to the Southeast corner of Lot 4 in Sunnyside Estates Unit 2, according to the plat thereof recorded December 4, 1939; thence South 30 degrees 55 minutes 00 seconds East, 13.00 feet to a line 13.00 feet Southerly of and parallel with said Northerly line of Sunnyside Beach Drive; thence North 59 degrees 05 minutes 00 seconds East along said parallel line, 982.92 feet; thence continuing along said parallel line North 46 degrees 14 minutes 48 seconds East, 330.51 feet to the Northeasterly line of said Sunnyside Beach Drive; thence South 43 degrees 45 minutes 12 seconds East along said Northeasterly line, 27.00 feet to the Southerly line of said Sunnyside Beach Drive; thence South 46 degrees 14 minutes 48 seconds West along said Southerly line, 333.55 feet; thence continuing along said Southerly line South 59 degrees 05 minutes 00 seconds West, 1,330.37 feet to the West line of said Lot 1 in Sunnyside Beach Subdivision; thence North 00 degrees 36 minutes 14 seconds East along said West line, 5.87 feet to the Point of Beginning, all in McHenry County, Illinois.

Excepting therefrom, That part of the Northwest and Northeast Quarters of Section 18, Township 45 North, Range 9 East of the Third Principal Meridian described as follows: Commencing at the Northwest corner of Lot 9 in Elam's Four Mile Water, according to the plat thereof recorded June 31, 1924 as Document No. 64619; thence South 58 degrees 38 minutes 47 seconds West along the Southwesterly extension of the Northerly line of said Lot 9, also being the Southerly line of Sunnyside Beach Drive as monumented and occupied, 99.39 feet to the Northwesterly extension of the Northeasterly line of Lot 11 in Elam's Four Mile Water, according to the plat thereof recorded August 27, 1920 as Document No. 48644, also being the Easterly line of Sunnyside Beach Drive as monumented and occupied; thence South 30 degrees 37 minutes 40 seconds East along said Easterly line, 61.03 feet to the Point of Beginning; thence continuing South 30 degrees 37 minutes 40 seconds East, 20.96 feet to a line 50.00 feet Northerly of and parallel with the Northerly line of Lots 11 through 18 in said Elam's Four Mile Water; thence South 58 degrees 21 minutes 39 seconds West along said parallel line, 99.47 feet; thence North 31 degrees 38

minutes 21 seconds West, 3.77 feet to a non-tangent curve; thence Northeasterly along a curve to the left, having a radius of 61.00 feet, a chord bearing of North 34 degrees 26 minutes 48 seconds East and a chord length of 40.05 feet, for an arc length of 40.81 feet to a non-tangent point; thence North 58 degrees 21 minutes 39 seconds East, 43.21 feet; thence North 30 degrees 37 minutes 40 seconds West, 14.53 feet; thence South 87 degrees 10 minutes 14 seconds East, 23.97 feet to the Point of Beginning, all in McHenry County, Illinois.

SECTION 2: If any section, paragraph, subdivision, clause, sentence or provision of this Ordinance shall be adjudged by any Court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such judgment shall not affect, impair, invalidate or nullify the remainder thereof, which remainder shall remain and continue in full force and effect.

SECTION 3: All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

SECTION 4: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form (which publication is hereby authorized) as provided by law.

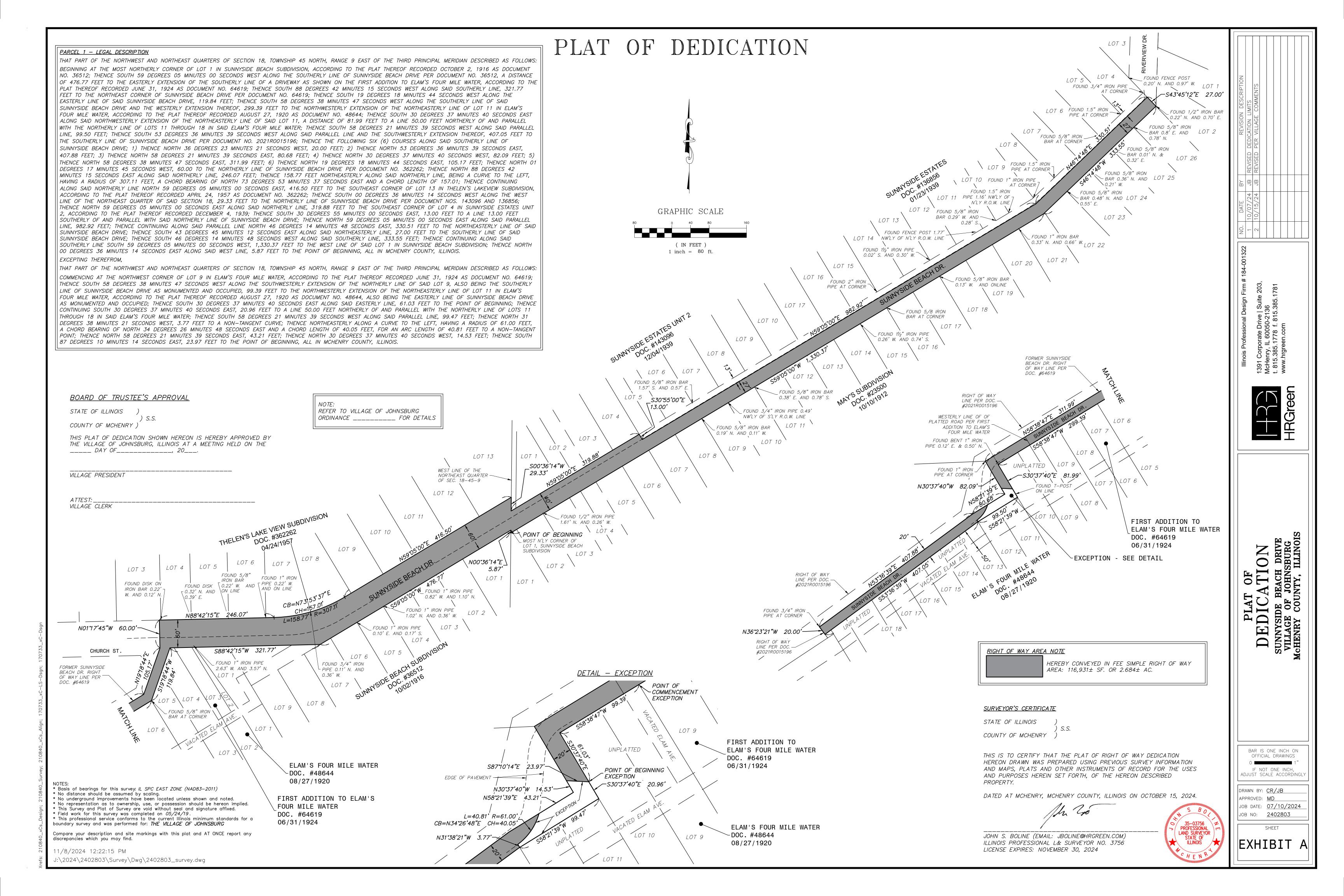
