Section 13 PERFORMANCE STANDARDS

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13.1 PURPOSE

The performance standards set forth herein are established to protect the public health, safety, comfort, convenience and the general welfare of the Village and to promote a more desirable environment in which to live and work within the Village.

13.2 NOISE

No person shall emit beyond the boundary of his property any sound that unreasonably interferes with another person's enjoyment of property or life or with any lawful business or activity or so as to violate any regulation set forth herein.

Lands are to be classified into three classes:

Class A is to consist of areas especially noise sensitive in that they incorporate sleeping quarters, namely, residential and institutional areas.

Class B is to consist of retail commercial and office commercial land uses, as well as recreational and open space uses.

Class C is to include all industrial and manufacturing uses.

The applicable land use designation for undeveloped land shall be determined by the predominant land use of the surrounding property or, if no use is predominant, by the most restrictive designation applicable to any of the surrounding property.

The following standards shall apply:

13.3 AIR POLLUTION

The Village hereby adopts the IEPA Air Pollution Regulations. The IEPA Air Pollution Regulations as adopted by the Illinois Pollution Control Board of April 14, 1972 and published by the IEPA and all amendments thereto, are hereby adopted by reference and made part of this section.

Copies of the IEPA Agency Air Pollution Regulations shall be kept on file in the Office of the Village Clerk for public inspection in accordance with 65 ILCS 5/1-3-1 et seq.

Any person who violates any provision of the IEPA Air Pollution Regulations shall be subject to Section 27, Violations; Penalties, of this Zoning Code.

13.4 WATER POLLUTION

The Village hereby adopts the IEPA Water Pollution Regulations. The IEPA Water Pollution Regulations as adopted by the Illinois Pollution Control Board on March 7, 1972 and published by the IEPA, and all amendments thereto, are hereby adopted by reference and made part of this Section 22.4.

Copies of the IEPA Water Pollution Regulations shall be kept on file in the Office of the Village Clerk for public inspection in accordance with 65 ILCS 5/1-3-1 et seq.

Any person who violates any provision of the IEPA Water Pollution Regulations shall be subject to Section 27, Violations; Penalties, of this Zoning Code.

13.5 OPEN BURNING

See Chapter 22, Comprehensive Fire & Burning Ordinance, of the Johnsburg Municipal Code.

13.6 ODORS

No odor shall be emitted by any use permitted in a zoning district in such quantities as to be readily detectable by an individual at any point on the lot line of the premises.

13.7 NOXIOUS GASES

Processes and operations of permitted uses capable of dispersing gases or toxic particulates into the atmosphere must be hooded or otherwise suitably enclosed. The emission of such toxic gases or particulate matter shall be from a stack.

13.8 GLARE AND HEAT

Operations producing intense light or heat shall be performed within an enclosed building and not be visible beyond any lot line bounding the property whereon the use is conducted.

13.9 VIBRATIONS

There shall be no uses which create heavy, earth-shaking vibrations which are noticeable at the lot line of the subject premises.
