**FROM THE FLOOR** - Tom Curry questioned why consideration of salaries was being conducted at the meeting rather than before the new board. President Hettermann explained that it is not unusual for the reviews to be done by the current board as they are the individuals that worked with the employees in the previous year. He added that it is done in that fashion by most communities and even at the county level, which was recently confirmed to him by County Board Member Pamela Althoff.

Keith Von Allmen read a statement expressing that he did not agree with the current board considering the salary adjustments and asked the board to wait on taking action until the new board is seated. He further expressed concern that the action was being taken absent the completion of the audit. President Hettermann again stated the reasons the current board is considering the matter and added that the salaries should be determined for inclusion in the budget. Village Administrator Sofiakis stated that the filing of the audit is expected the following day.
