PRESIDENT'S REPORT - President Hettermann reminded all about the upcoming Council of Government event and appointed Colt Rogers to the Finance Committee, Sydney Kraus to the Community Affairs Committee and Samuel Shafer to the Development and Governmental Affairs Committee.

SPRING GROVE BOUNDARY AGREEMENT HEARING - Attorney Michael Smoron opened the public hearing on a proposed Boundary Agreement between the Village of Johnsburg and the Village of Spring Grove at 7:03 p.m. There were no comments from the public and the hearing was closed.

Trustee Josh Hagen moved to a Boundary Agreement between the Village of Johnsburg and the Village of Spring Grove. Trustee Letzter seconded the motion. All Trustees present voted aye on the roll. Motion carried.

APPROPRIATION HEARING – Attorney Smoron opened the public hearing on the proposed Appropriations for FY 2027 at 7:04 p.m. There were no public comments and the hearing was closed.

Trustee Letzter moved to approve Ordinance 26-27-02 An Ordinance Making Appropriations for General Corporate Purposes for the Village of Johnsburg for Fiscal Year Beginning May 1, 2026 and Ending April 30, 2027. Trustee Von Allmen seconded the motion. Trustee Letzter questioned the additional dollars included in the Sewer and Water Fund and if they would be sufficient. Village Administrator Sofiakis explained that the revenues proposed to cover any unforeseen expenses should be sufficient to cover unforeseen repairs and replacements and the Village would rely on funds set aside in the Capital Plan to support the additional expenses. She stated that much consideration is given when establishing the appropriations and explained the limitations on amending the ordinance. All Trustees present voted aye on the roll. Motion carried.

ADJOURNMENT – Trustee Von Allmen moved to adjourn the meeting. Trustee Fouke seconded the motion. All Trustees voted aye on the roll. Motion carried at 7:10 p.m.
