Village of Johnsburg Non-Highway Vehicle Permit Application

The Non-Highway Vehicle Permit Applicant should complete the following form in its entirety prior to scheduling a time for inspection. Applicants and drivers should read local <u>Municipal Code Chapter 15.15</u> regarding the Operation of Non-Highway Vehicles on Village Streets and the FAQ provided. It is the responsibility of the vehicle owner and operators to know and abide by all provisions of the ordinance. Upon completion, return this form to the Village of Johnsburg Village Hall, 1515 Channel Beach, Johnsburg, IL 60051.

The following Operation Regulations are important for owners and operators:

- Must only be operated on streets where the posted speed limit is 35 MPH or less.
- May cross a designated street at an intersection where the street has a posted speed limit of no more than 35 MPH.
- Operation is only permitted on Village streets when the driver has a valid driver's license in his or her name issued by the Secretary of State.
- Shall yield the right of way to all pedestrians and vehicular traffic, which constitutes a hazard.
- Operation in compliance with the provision of the Illinois Vehicle Code (625 ILCS/5/ Illinois Vehicle Code).

No permit shall be granted unless the following conditions are met:

- 1. The non-highway vehicle (golf cart or rec. off-highway vehicle) must pass an inspection for all required equipment. Permitted vehicles must be less than or equal to 64" to qualify by Illinois State Statute.
- 2. The applicant must provide evidence of insurance in compliance with the provisions of the Illinois Compiled Statutes regarding minimum liability insurance.
- 3. Applicants must possess a valid driver's license.

The applicant has received and read a copy of the Village of Johnsburg ordinance concerning the registration and operation of Non-Highway Vehicles and understands that the village may suspend or revoke a permit granted hereunder upon a finding that the holder thereof has violated any provisions of the Johnsburg Village Ordinance governing Non- Highway Vehicles, or there is evidence that the permittee cannot safely operate a qualified vehicle on the designated roadway.

Any person operating the non-highway vehicle is subject to all laws of the Illinois Vehicle Code including Driving under the Influence of Alcohol or Drugs. The passenger capacity of the vehicle cannot be exceeded. Any person, who violates any provisions of Municipal Code Chapter 15.15, is guilty of a petty offense and shall be fined not more than a Class C (\$200.00) on the first offense followed by Class D (\$400.00) on the second offense and a Class E (\$750.00) on third offense to include responsibility for the Villages cost of prosecution including reasonable attorney fees.

By signing this application, the applicant hereby releases the Village of Johnsburg, its elected officials and its employees and agrees to indemnify and hold them harmless from any and all claims resulting from the operation of this non-highway vehicle on public streets.
