

**MINUTES OF THE VILLAGE OF JOHNSBURG
APRIL 23, 2014 MEETING OF THE
DEVELOPMENT AND GOVERNMENTAL AFFAIRS COMMITTEE**

CALL TO ORDER – Chairman Klemstein called the meeting to order at 6:33 p.m. in the Village Hall.

MINUTES – Committee Member Adams moved to approve the minutes of the March 26, 2014 meeting. Committee Member Doyle seconded the motion. All Committee Members present voted aye. Motion carried.

CHAIRMAN’S REPORT – Chairman Klemstein reported on the Village Board meeting. He reported on the ordinances approved by the Board, the status of the Garrelts request for a conditional use permit and a presentation by Village Administrator, Claudett Peters and Village Engineer, Tim Hartnett regarding ongoing efforts to extend sewer infrastructure.

OLD BUSINESS – Chairman Klemstein informed the committee that the Board suggested they take another look at street sign alternatives. The committee expressed that Village funds should go towards road improvements rather than signage and do not believe the more decorative signs bring value to the Village. They further stated that if a subdivision elects to pursue the more expensive signage and they need to be replaced in the future, the Village should reimburse the subdivision the amount for replacing the Village’s standard sign with the understanding that the subdivision will be responsible for the cost difference. Committee Member Adams stated that he would rather go with the Tapco signs with reflective font and the Village logo than spend the additional funds for the higher priced signs. He stated that the Village could consider a different color such as black or brown if preferred.

Motion by Committee Member Adams to recommend the Tapco signs to the Board. Seconded by Committee Member Doyle. All Committee Members present voted aye. Motion carried.

Committee Member Adams requested a report listing all new building permits being issued and pending.

NEW BUSINESS – Chairman Klemstein would like to discuss the street lighting at the next meeting after he obtains some additional information.

Committee Member Adams questioned the status of four properties located on River Terrace that were public access to the River. Chairman Klemstein stated that he would look into it.

ADJOURNMENT – Committee Member Doyle moved that the meeting adjourn. Committee Member Adams seconded the motion. All Committee Members present voted aye. Motion carried at 7:06 p.m.
