ORDINANCE NO. 2019-20-06 An Ordinance Amending Chapter 7.01 Business Registration, of the Johnsburg Municipal Code

BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Johnsburg, McHenry County, Illinois, as follows:

SECTION 1: That Section 7.01Business Registration of the Johnsburg Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

7.01 BUSINESS REGISTRATION

- A. <u>Purpose and Jurisdiction</u>: Because each business establishment in the Village is a basic part of and affects the physical and economic well-being of the Village, this section is designed to keep a current listing of businesses operating in the Village, aid the Police Department in its responsibilities and provide a cross check for sales tax collections.
- B. <u>Registration</u>, Fee: All businesses with buildings, premises or operating from a residence in the Village shall register with the Village Clerk no later than April 30th of each year. Registration questionnaires shall be made available by the Village and returned along with the annual registration fee of \$25.00 to the Village Clerk by April 30th. <u>The fee shall be waived for all not for profit businesses</u>.
- C. Any salon or barber shop that employs people who practice barbering, cosmetology, esthetics, hair braiding or nail technology are required to be registered with the Illinois Department of Financial and Professional Regulation. Additionally, the individual practitioner needs to maintain an active license to practice in the State of Illinois. At the time of registering the business with the Village, proof of an active registration with the State of Illinois is required to be submitted to the Village for the business and each individual practitioner employed by such business. If the business or any of its professional staff does not comply with these requirements, a Class H penalty will be assessed for each offense.
- D. <u>Registration Certificates</u>: It shall be the duty of any person conducting a registered business in the Village to keep his registration posted in a prominent place on the premises used for such business at all times.
- E. Penalties: Failure to register a business by April 30th constitutes a Class A violation as prescribed in Chapter 1.07-E.

SECTION 2: If any section, paragraph, subdivision, clause, sentence or provision of this Ordinance shall be adjudged by any Court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such judgment shall not affect, impair, invalidate or nullify the remainder thereof, which remainder shall remain and continue in full force and effect.

SECTION 3: All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

SECTION 4: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form (which publication is hereby authorized) as provided by law.
