## **ORDINANCE NO. 19-20-17**

## An Ordinance Amending Section 1.6, Penalties, and 1.7, Settlement of Offenses, of the Johnsburg Municipal Code

WHEREAS, the Village of Johnsburg is an Illinois municipal corporation in McHenry County ("Village") and pursuant to the Illinois Municipal Code, the Village has the authority to amend the official Johnsburg Municipal Code; and

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF JOHNSBURG, ILLINOIS, as follows:

- SECTION 1. That Section 1.6, paragraph A., of Chapter 1 of the Johnsburg Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as follows:
  - A. <u>Standard Penalty</u>. Unless another penalty is specifically provided by this Code for violation of any particular provision, section or chapter, any person violating any provision of this Code, or any rule or regulation adopted or issued in pursuance thereof, or any provision of any code adopted herein by reference, shall upon conviction or similar disposition be subject to a fine not less than fifty dollars (\$50.00) nor more than seven hundred and fifty dollars (\$750.00) per offense.
- SECTION 2. That Section 1.7, Settlement of Offenses, paragraph A., of Chapter 1 of the Johnsburg Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as follows:
  - A. The purpose of this system is to give the public an opportunity to pay fine(s) without the addition of court costs or requirement of court appearance(s). Nothing in this Section shall limit the Village from initiating a complaint for ordinance violation or similar pleading that sets mandatory court appearances and/or does not provide for the opportunity to settle.
- SECTION 3. The provisions and sections of this Ordinance shall be deemed to be separable, and the invalidity of any portion of this Ordinance shall not affect the validity of the remainder.
- SECTION 4. All ordinances, resolutions, rules and orders, or parts thereof, in conflict herewith, are to the extent of such conflict hereby superseded.
- SECTION 5. A full, true and complete copy of this Ordinance shall be published in pamphlet form as provided by the Illinois Municipal Code, as amended. The Village Clerk is hereby directed to publish this Ordinance in pamphlet form.

SECTION 6. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval, and publication as required by law.
