# Ordinance 20-21-05 An Ordinance Authorizing the Sale of Public Property or Dispose/Destroy Owned by the Village of Johnsburg

**WHEREAS**, the **Village of Johnsburg**, McHenry County, Illinois, is in the opinion of a simple majority of the corporate authorities of the Village of Johnsburg, McHenry County, Illinois, and as provided in 65 ILCS 5/11-76-4 and:

WHEREAS, in the opinion of the corporate authorities of the Village of Johnsburg, it is no longer necessary or useful to or for the best interests of the Village of Johnsburg to retain ownership of the public property hereinafter described; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined by the Village President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Johnsburg to sell said public property for cash.

# NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF JOHNSBURG, as follows:

**SECTION 1:** The Village President and Board of Trustees of the **Village of Johnsburg** find that the following described public property now owned by said jurisdiction is no longer necessary to said jurisdiction and said jurisdiction would be best served by the said public property sale:

Three (3) push lawn mowers (2 Toro (2-Stroke) & 1 Yard Machine (4-Stroke)) that have not been utilized according to Public Works Foreman for many years and require maintenance to be operation.

One (1) LESO issued All-Terrain Vehicle that requires extensive maintenance and deemed non-operational for emergency response; Honda, TRX-450ES ATV, S/N: 478TE1500RA624748. Proceeds from sale must go to Police Department vehicle fund according to Law Enforcement Support Office (LESO) - Surplus Property.

One (1) Matco LESO issued General Toolbox 28" that is deemed non-useful; NSN 5180-00-699-5273, proceeds from sale must go to Police Department general fund according to Law Enforcement Support Office (LESO) - Surplus Property,

Appendix A - municipal police equipment that has reached its shelf life consisting of portable radios and office computer base equipment no longer functional and directed for disposal/destroyed.

SECTION 2: The Village Administrator is hereby authorized and directed to auction said equipment, via public auction services, if necessary, Obenauf Auction Services Inc., 810 Magna Drive Round Lake, IL 60073 with a reserve set for said property sale or sealed bids from internal employees and local residence or dispose/destroy.

**SECTION 3:** Upon payment in full, the Village Administrator is hereby authorized and directed to convey and/or transfer the aforesaid property to the respective buyer.
