<b>Old Business</b>	Committee reviewed stats from JBPD, Mr. Lamontagna reported police tracker provided from statistical data. Member Bierman inquired why only three (3) ordinance violation of all Village ordinance and would like to see all the records available for ordinances from the committee.	Staff to continue updating Tracker on mentioned enforcement violations for ORD review. Provide further input on all enforcement and ordinance violations logged and status for ORD Review.
<b>New Business</b>	Chairmen Frost requested staff to collaborate with surround municipalities regarding Abandonment and Neglected properties/dwelling specifically regarding conditions, structural concerns and property maintenance management. Staff provided some findings and explained the implementations involved regarding court orders and McHenry County involvement required. Shared collaborated findings and narrowed down some properties ORD committee wanted further investigation into. Member Gebis stated in summary the documents provided was many sources and not enough time was provided to review and provide further input. ORD committee discussed some further correspondence provided and tabled the discussion for committee review prior to further developed possible new dedicated Municipal Chapter.
