- Replaced a faulty line going to a hydrant

### **OLD BUSINESS**

The Lakemoor boat ramp has been stopped for now by McHenry County.

HR Green has drawn up plans to improve Johnsburg's boat ramp but the project is costly. Chairman McEvoy is talking with the Village Administrator to see if it would be feasible to start this project and do it in three stages.

#### **NEW BUSINESS**

Chairman McEvoy reported that the roundabout should be open to traffic at the end of the week. The roundabout was tested to large vehicles such as fire trucks and school buses to demonstrate that they can use the roundabout. The committee also discussed installing an electronic security fence at the Public Works facilities.
