Village Board Report – September 2018

Welcome to the Village Board Report, which is placed on our website monthly to keep you informed of actions taken by the Village Board on ordinances and other significant matters.

RUNNING BROOK FARMS PARK – At the September 18, 2018 meeting the board approved Pay Request #1 in an amount of \$58,199.26 to Copenhaver Construction for improvements at Running Brook Farms Park.

BOND REFUNDING – At the September 18, 2018 meeting, the Board discussed the refunding of Waterworks Sewerage Bonds, originally issued in 2009. Consideration of the refunding is in an effort to obtain competitive interest rates, resulting in a potential savings of approximately \$55,000. The Board moved to accept Authorization of Engagement Letters from Bernardi Securities and Ice Miller LLC for bond underwriting and bond/disclosure services related to the refunding of the Waterworks Sewerage Bonds. The Board will consider a Bond Parameters Ordinance at the October 2, 2018 meeting.

Chapter 24.19 EXCEPTION - At the September 18, 2018 meeting, the Board heard a request for an exception to Chapter 24.19 - Garages, of the Johnsburg Municipal Code related to the property at 1401 River Terrace Drive. The request is to accommodate closing off an existing attached garage. The Board reached consensus to permit the exception and will consider an ordinance ratifying the action at the October 2, 2018 meeting.
