BUSH SCHOOL DEVELOPMENT – At the July 2nd meeting, the Board authorized the execution of a proposal from SB Friedman to develop a tax increment financing district in support of General Capital Group's redevelopment of the former Bush School property.

COLD STORAGE FACILITY – At the July 2nd meeting, the Board accepted the bid from Carmichael Construction for construction of a cold storage facility at the Public Works facility.
